**Intro-** Luke 7:44 “..but she \_\_\_\_\_ my feet with her tears...”

**1. \_\_\_\_\_ Has Wet Feet**

And \_\_\_\_\_ got his feet wet? This woman whose life is filled with \_\_\_\_\_, struggles and sin.
