

**I. Discouraged**

--There is a look that says: "It's too \_\_\_\_\_."

--Peter felt it was too late to \_\_\_\_\_ any \_\_\_\_\_.

--Vs. 5: "*Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught \_\_\_\_\_*..."

--Peter and the other disciples have tried so \_\_\_\_\_ and caught \_\_\_\_\_.

--Vs. 4 – Jesus says: "*Put down into \_\_\_\_\_ water...*"

**II. Faith.**

**III. Blessed**

with blessings. What is Peter's reaction? Vs. 8: "*Peter*

*\_\_\_\_\_ at Jesus' knees...*" "*Go away from me, \_\_\_\_\_, I am a sinful man.*" Jesus says; "*Don't be \_\_\_\_\_....*" Vs. 10

--Notice: Jesus doesn't just recruit the \_\_\_\_\_ and the \_\_\_\_\_ people - Jesus uses the beat up and \_\_\_\_\_.

--This story is not just about fishing, but it is about \_\_\_\_\_.

**I. Satan Bound (verses 1-6)**

#1.Vs 2: Satan appears as a \_\_\_\_\_. The chains symbolize the fact that Satan's \_\_\_\_\_ is \_\_\_\_\_.

#2.Vs. 3 – The Millennium (\_\_\_\_\_ years) when Satan is bound is interpreted in 3 different ways:

**A. Post-millennialists** = believe Jesus will return \_\_\_\_\_ the world enjoys 1000 years of peace.

**B. Pre-millennialists** = believe the 1000 years is literal and is an \_\_\_\_\_ number. They believe Jesus will \_\_\_\_\_ to earth and reign in \_\_\_\_\_ for 1000 years.

**C. Amillennialists** = we believe this number is \_\_\_\_\_. It represents the \_\_\_\_\_ period of time between Jesus' first coming and His \_\_\_\_\_ coming. During this time, Satan cannot deceive the \_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 3) See Luke 10:17,18 John 12:31, Colossians 2:15 and Matthew 12:28, 29.

**II. Satan Released (verses 7-9)**
